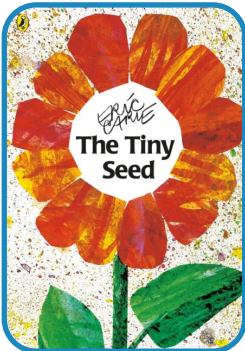
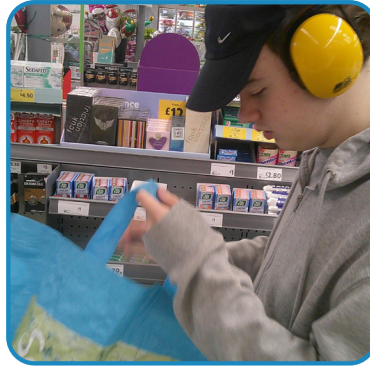


St John's News
